



## **ENROLLMENT IN MESM CORE COURSES**

Enrollment in MESM Core Courses (ESM 201, 202, 203, 204, 206, 207, 210, 241, and 251) is generally limited to Bren MESM students.

MESM core courses are designed for MESM students. However, at times, a student and his/her faculty advisor will determine that a MESM core course may provide valuable knowledge and skills for the student's research, adequate background to take other graduate-level courses, or preparation to serve as a TA in future years.

As such, PhD or Master's students ***under the mentorship*** of a Bren faculty member may be approved to enroll in a core course. The courses are structured to limit enrollment to MESM students on GOLD; requests from non-MESM students should be sent to [scheduling@bren.ucsb.edu](mailto:scheduling@bren.ucsb.edu).

Top priority for enrollment is extended to MESM students. However, undergraduates or Extension students in these courses may be accommodated with permission from the instructor if there is space in the class.
