Course Description

This seminar course is intended to build off other Bren courses and focus on current issues pertaining to the National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA") and California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"). I will provide a brief overview of the statutes and regulations to support the case illustrations that will be discussed in class. For our case studies, I have selected issues involving oil development, land use, and climate change. I will discuss the application of NEPA and CEQA to these matters, and provide examples of how the public can invoke the requirements of NEPA and CEQA to ensure that decision-makers adequately consider environmental concerns. In addition to the lecture, I will provide related reading materials and optional reading materials, as well as examples of cases and real-life administrative processes in which students can consider participating.
