**Goals of Program:** The graduate intern will work with our Stewardship team on environmental projects and provide mentorship for their partnered undergraduate intern. They will research and vet MMRV (measurement, monitoring, reporting and verification) external consultant/software programs, integral to our Climate Action Plan and goals. The intern will also help the organization assess readiness for upcoming sustainability regulations, benchmark competitor and customer sustainability programs and goals, conduct background research on lead NGOs, and assist with other projects as identified.

In addition to Bren BEL program support, you’ll join other Tillamook interns at multiple experiences include visiting dairy farms in Tillamook, immersive cheese and ice cream tastings, “college-inspired” cooking class with our executive chef, resume & interview workshop, a sales market tours and much more!

The position is 10 weeks, 35 hours per week, with exact dates flexible between late June to mid-September and located in Portland, OR. The student will receive an \$8,500 stipend. Tillamook will also offer an additional \$1,500 travel stipend to accommodate costs associated with moving to Portland for the summer. This position is part of the Bren Environmental Leadership Program – the student will attend mentoring and leadership training during Spring Quarter and mentor an undergraduate student working on the project throughout the summer.
