Former Deputy Secretary and Chief Operating Officer

Lynn Scarlett is the former Deputy Secretary and Chief Operating Officer of the U.S. Department of the Interior and former Chief External Affairs Officer at The Nature Conservancy. She serves on the Advisory Council of the National Center for Ecological Analysis and Synthesis, is Vice Chair of the National Wildlife Refuge Association, and serves on the Board of the Santa Barbara Foundation. She chaired the Science Advisory Board of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration for six years and served on the Board of Advisors of the Cornell Lab of Ornithology. She received her MA in political science from UC Santa Barbara, where she also completed her PhD coursework and exams in political science. She is currently chair of the Bren School's Dean's Council.

IN MEMORIAM

Distinguished Professor Emeritus and Founding Dean Jeff Dozier

We were deeply saddened this year by the passing of Distinguished Professor Emeritus Jeff Dozier. In 1994, Chancellor Yang selected Professor Dozier as the founding dean of the Bren School. He was a pioneering researcher and scientist whose work crossed multiple disciplines, with a particular focus on snow hydrology, Earth system science, remote sensing, and information systems. A global leader in his field, Professor Dozier was also known as a devoted teacher and mentor, and an admired colleague who provided support, encouragement, and inspiration to all.

To honor his legacy, the Bren School has established the annual Jeff Dozier Memorial Seminar featuring prominent scientists who share his dedication to interdisciplinary environmental problem solving.
